Dear parents and carers,

Today we have met with year ten to discuss their GCSEs and the importance of effective studying when preparing for examinations. We have developed a form time revision plan for year ten; this will focus on the core subjects each day in form time, excluding one day each week which is set aside for Collective Worship. Leaders have been planning the best way to use this time so that it is purposeful for your child, therefore attendance to form is vital as part of our important intervention plan. Next half term we are starting with science revision; we have bought every child a revision text book which we will show them how to use when the new term starts.

We have planned a timetable of mock examinations for the summer term (this is on the school website). These will take place between 21st June and 30th June and will help us to plan our provision for your child's return in year eleven. These examinations are important. Firstly, they are an effective way for us to collect evidence about your child's progress; in addition, it will help us to support pupils if any gaps have emerged. To support our year ten pupils to plan for these exams, we have designed revision sessions which focus on the best ways to revise to support memory which form tutors will deliver on the first week back after the holiday.
