Dear Parents/Carers,

In September 2024, your child will start a new chapter in their life as they join our school, and we are looking forward to welcoming them to our community. To help prepare for this, we warmly invite your child to our Transition Days on **Thursday 4th 2024**. This day is important because it will help children to get to know the school, pupils and staff, and to start their journey towards becoming valued members of our community.

Your child should arrive at All Saints for 8.50am, with a view to starting the Transition Day at 9.00am. They should come through the main entrance on Birch Lane, where they will be greeted by our staff. The school day will finish at 2.55pm.

The children will take part in a number of lessons, and will need to bring pens, pencils, a ruler and a rubber. Your child will be introduced to the other pupils who will be joining All Saints in September 2024, and there will be opportunities to mix with them during the course of the transition day.

On Thursday 4th July, they should wear their primary school PE kit, including outdoor footwear. If the weather is fine, we will be holding sports activities outside during the day; if not, we will be inside doing friendship-building activities. **Please make sure your child brings sunscreen and water if the weather is warm on the Thursday.**

On the Transition Day, a meal from our canteen will be provided for all pupils. Meals will be provided by Mellors, the catering company who run our canteen, and you will not be asked to pay for this. However, children should bring their own snacks for break times.
