

All Saints Summer school programme 2021

All Saints Summer School took place Monday-Friday (excluding Wednesday). Sessions were aimed at pupils in year six who primary staff felt had fallen behind or needed additional support, due to the Covid pandemic. The activities which took place on the Friday were aimed at SEND pupils. The sessions were tailored to support the needs of these pupils and a greater emphasis was placed on familiarising pupils with expectations, systems and routines. At the end of each day all pupils chose a book, which we had purchased for them, to encourage them to carry on reading until their return to school. We had s76 children attend our summer school, though only thirty responded to the evaluation.
