Dear parent/carers,

It is important to us that you understand your child's progress. We are reporting to you using the skills your child has been taught each term across all of their subjects. The benefit of this approach is that teachers and parents can look more closely at the specific skills and knowledge pupils cover to best prepare them for key stage four.

Your child's report will contain a summary of their progress towards Mastery. Your child's individual understanding of their subjects will be graded using the following terms:

Term	Explanation
No grade awarded	Absent
Not accessing	the pupil is not yet working at a level which is expected for a child of their age
Emerging	the pupil is not always working at the expected level
Developing	the pupil has shown that they are secure in the knowledge and skills within statement and are confident in it
Secure	the pupil has excelled and shown that they are working at the highest level for their current age

We hope that you find this system of reporting useful in understanding your child's progress and supporting their improvement in any areas which they have not mastered yet. During parents evening you will have the opportunity to discuss your child's progress in depth with their class teacher.

Reporting in numerical GCSE grades will commence in Key Stage 4.
