## Fortnightly library lessons

- Reading in groups with their peers
- Reading in groups led by an adult
- Reading independently (followed by 1-1 reading with class teacher)
- Pupils take a book home and should read within the fortnight



## Accelerated Reader

- Data generated from reading tests to give a guide of the most suitable books
- Pupils can quiz on books and there is a competition
- Parents can access information from home via
- <https://allsaintscatholiccollege.com/itservices> - select Accelerated Reader (Parent Portal) and enter your child's login details (these are the same ones they use in school to access Accelerated Reader/Star Reading test).
- Click on 'email setup' in the top right-hand corner to sign up for quiz notifications.



## STAR reading

- Reading ages won't necessarily reflect chronological age
- We share **NRSS** with pupils – 100 is their personal age related expectation
- We share **Percentile Rank** with parents – reading at the same or better level than % of peers
- Pupils complete three readings tests three times year – informs any intervention





## Fortnightly Lexia lessons

Programme is bespoke to them – immediately address any gaps in knowledge or develop skills further

Pupils receive skills builders to take home to complete (generated after each session)

Pupils receive 1-1 or small group intervention in lessons to address any misconceptions that are flagged while completing the programme.

Pupils should be completing Lexia for 1-1.5 hours a week.
