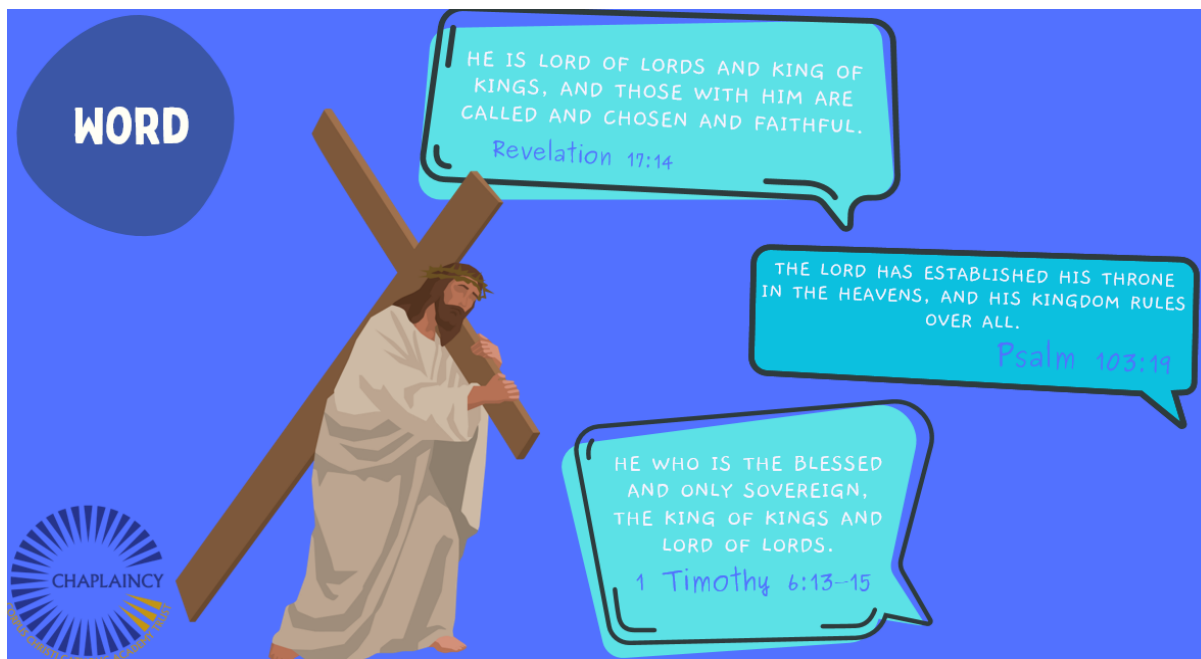


Parent Bulletin 22/11/24

Willow Wood

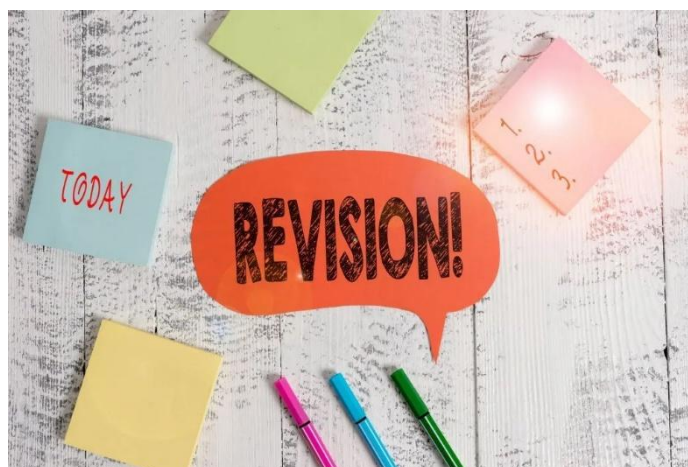
