

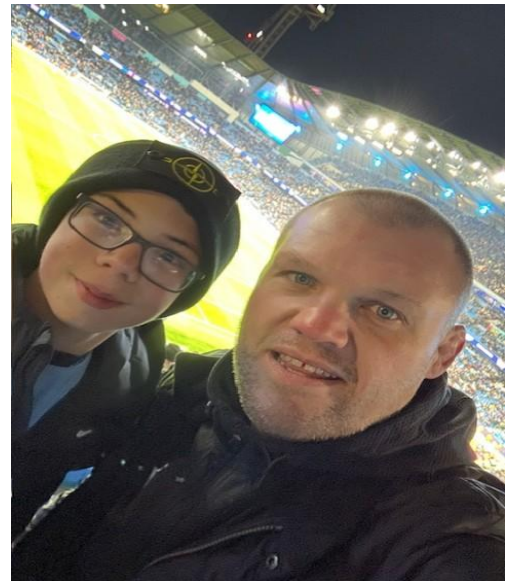


20 Questions

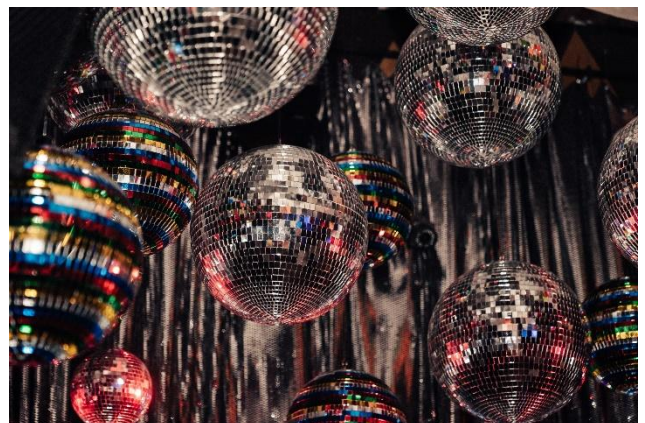
Christmas Carol Concert
