

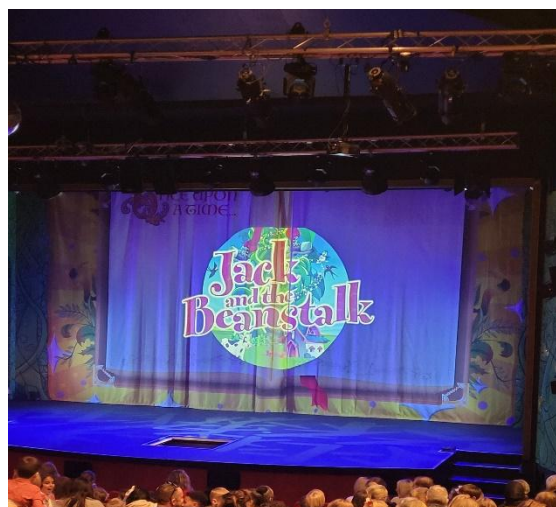
### Welcome Message

## Fundraising for Willow Wood Hospice

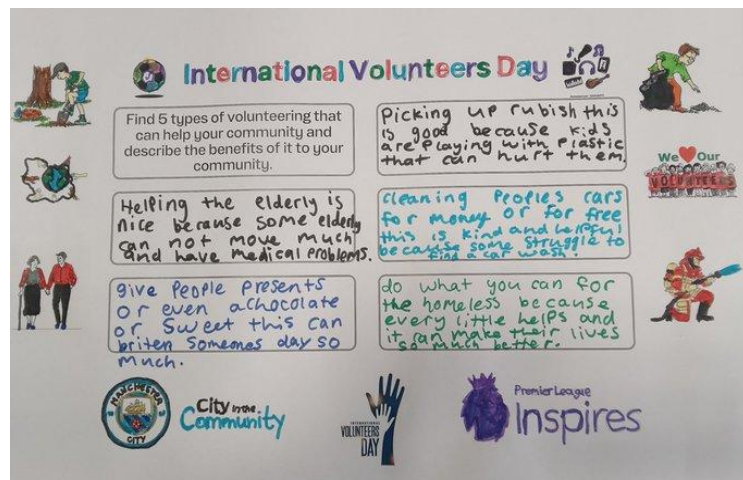
