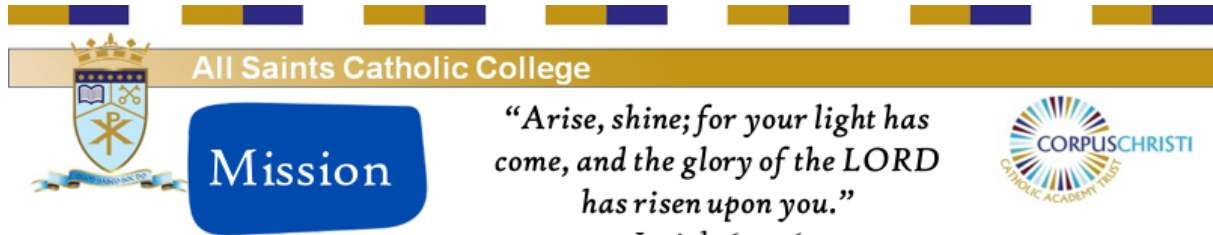


"You are the light of the world."
