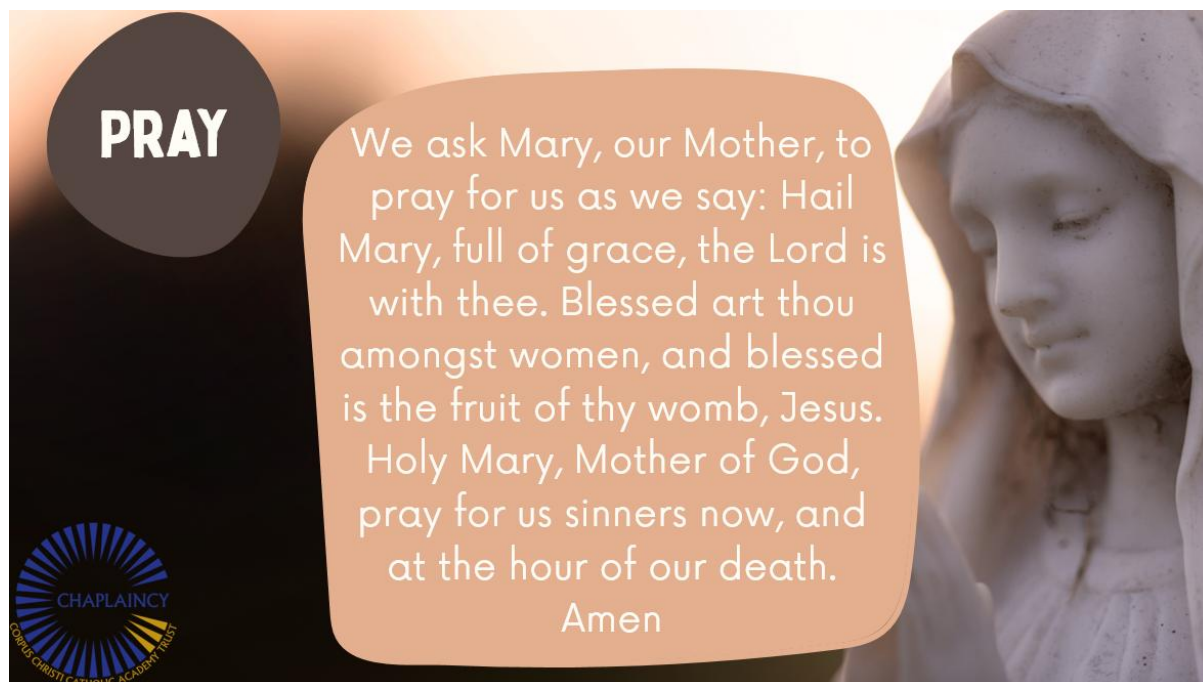

Year 11 Parents Evening

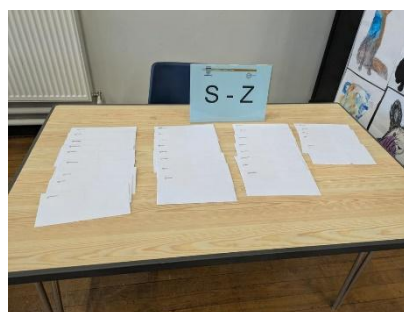
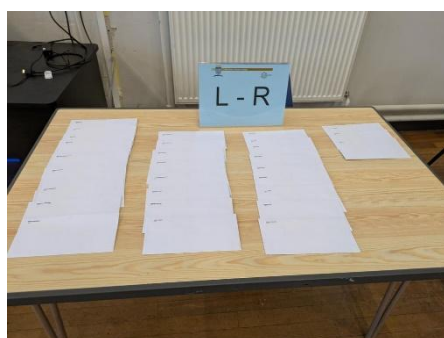
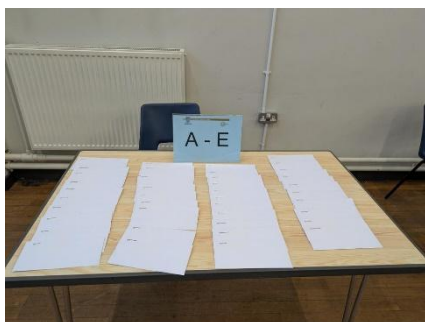
